Mayor Lamb stated that the purpose of this meeting was to discuss the Joint Farmersville/Jackson Township Park and how to move forward and manage the Park Together.

Trustee, Ryan Hodson suggested that the Park Board and their By-Laws should be re-instated. The By-Laws state that the Park Board would be made up of three Jackson Township residents and two Village of Farmersville residents. It was also suggested that Mr. Shell should become the Park Administrator and the Park Board would determine the pay and hours., this position is a non-voting position. Both entities will need to vote to reinstate the Park Board. It was decided that there would be another Joint Meeting between both entities at 5:30 p.m. on March 9 to further discuss Park Board.

Mayor Lamb said that a contract has been created between the city of Germantown and the (future) Park Board to work together on the hiring and staffing of both the Germantown and Farmersville Pool. In addition, the Miami University Report for the Park has been completed and will be uploaded to the Village website and encourages community input.

Mr. Shell stated that Rodney Creech said there is up to \$200,000 in state grant money we could apply for to put towards the playground equipment. Mr. Shell will work on getting quotes.
