FIRE: Chief Erisman

- Chief Erisman stated that they have been very busy and have had 51 runs already.

POLICE: Chief Bruner – notes read by Mr. Hodson

- In January, Officers were dispatched to 99 calls for service and took 55 reports. Officers responded to:
 - 7 motor vehicle crashes
 - 18 traffic stops were made
 - 9 citations given
 - 13 warnings
 - 5 arrests
- Chief Bruner referenced a purchase order he created # 2026-001. He requested approval to purchase a 2026 Dodge Durango Pursuit AWD from Byers Chrysler Dodge Ram in the amount of \$47,724.00 (total build cost not to exceed \$58,000 per budget). This will replace the 2019 Dodge Charger which has approximately 130,000 miles on it. Chief Bruner stated with the recent snow this winter the other two AWD vehicles have been running a lot. Mrs. Kozarec stated that the purchase order he created was not valid as 1) it was already in use and 2) these have to be created through UAN. Mrs. Kozarec said she would create a purchase order with a new number. Mr. Hodson made motion to approve the purchase of the Dodge Pursuit and Mr. Erisman seconded the motion. Motion Passed.

- Chief Bruner thanked Mr. Pohl for allowing him to use the skid steer for snow removal.
- Mr. Moyer asked Chief Bruner if the Ditch Witch was still out at the park? (This is a piece of equipment used and stored by a contractor working for Spectrum putting in Fiber Optic lines, they have since gone out of business and left equipment). Chief Bruner stated it is and he has the serial number on it but needs a complaint from the Village of Farmersville since they are the property owners. He will also have Englewood Tow come look at it since it is quite large.
- Mr. Moyer asked about the Drone and whether there was a program in place for it? Chief stated that Jon Schade is certified and you must be certified to use it. Mr. Moyer requested that a full-time officer be certified in case Jon is not available.

- Mr. Moyer asked about the speed warning sign? Chief said it is not operable and he is waiting on a cable for repair.

ROAD: Mr. Pohl

- Working on pipe replacement on Eagle Road.
- Plowing a LOT of snow.
- Mr. Pohl thanked Chief Bruner for operating the skid steer and clearing snow.
- Mr. Pohl would like to purchase a new Mi-Y-M hot water pressure washer for up to \$10,000. He sold the previous one for \$5,000 and will use that towards this purchase. Mr. Hodson made motion to approve the purchase and Mr. Erisman seconded the motion. Motion passed.

- Mr. Pohl stated he is looking into selling the John Deere 570A grader and replacing it with 2 attachments for the S650 Skid Steer: a soil conditioner and grader attachment. Since the John Deere is worth more than \$2500, we will need a resolution so Trustees tabled the vote until next meeting.

- Recycling Center camera grant, total price for cameras is \$9,748.78. We will receive \$6,824.15 from the grant making the Township/Park cost \$2,924.63. Mr. Moyer made motion to approve the new cameras and Mr. Erisman seconded the motion. Motion Passed.

Resolution 2026-06 – Cyber Security Policy between Jackson Township and Elite Computers. Chief Bruner brought up concerns regarding the cost to the Police since they have 9 computers and will be charged \$60/month (\$540 month). He also felt that the state puts these requirements in place but like the MARCS radio and body worn camera’s policy those that waited were granted money to help cover the costs. He said he wonders if he replaced all the MDT’s with iPads to save money since Elite Computers said they don’t have to put any software on the Apple products. He asked if the General Fund could help pay for his department costs – Mr. Hodson asked Mrs. Kozarec what the General Fund balance was? Mrs. Kozarec referred him to the Fund Balance sheet that showed the General Fund having a balance of \$172,693.55 and the Police Fund having a balance of \$1,087,964.67. Mr. Moyer suggested that we approve the Cyber Policy as it is required by the Auditor of State and he does not want to put the Township or Trustees in any problems and they revisit the cost of helping the Police in June. Mr. Erisman made motion to approve the Cyber Security Policy and Mr. Hodson seconded the motion. Motion Passed.
